



The 6th Edition of 'The Spirit of Democracy Weekend' at Costa Navarino, concludes following inspirational debates by creative leaders

 Key speakers including artist Ai Weiwei, historian Bettany Hughes and author Elif Shafak, explored the importance of embracing the cultural differences of East and West to bring greater democracy to nations



8 October 2021 - Costa Navarino, the prime sustainable destination in the Mediterranean, welcomed **world-acclaimed speakers** including award-winning novelist **Elif Shafak**, renowned contemporary artist **Ai Weiwei**, and historian, author and broadcaster **Bettany Hughes**, to lead a series of discussions and debates, as part of the sixth edition of **'The Spirit of Democracy Weekend'** which took place 1 - 3 October 2021, in partnership with the **Athens Democracy Forum**.

"We're living in an age of misinformation and we need to focus more on knowledge. Ultimately, we need wisdom – for that we need to bring the mind and the heart together, we need a bit more compassion", commented **Elif Shafak** in her virtual conversation with Patrick Healy, Deputy Opinion Editor from The New York Times, while discussing the role of literature in democracy and current affairs, as well as her latest book "How to Stay Sane in an Age of Division".

Artist and activist **Ai Weiwei** also tuned in virtually for a discussion moderated by Liz Alderman, Chief European Business Correspondent from The New York Times, ahead of his long-awaited book due for release in November "1,000 years of Joys and Sorrows: A Memoir" focusing on his personal experience as well his fathers' story whilst in detention. When asked about the role of art expression in democracy as a tool of activism, he explained: "Art is an extension of my life. It's what I believe. It's not a struggle for freedom...but rather freedom represented in some kind of artistic way".

Additionally, acclaimed historian **Bettany Hughes**, explored the differences and common characteristics between Eastern and Western philosophies and how the ideas of Socrates and Confucius influenced the two civilizations. Talking to Steven Erlanger, Chief European Diplomatic Correspondent from The New York Times, she commented on their common ground: "What they all say is that enquiry is not seditious but central to what it is to be human and to live in healthy society - and that you can only find truth by asking questions, and that truth isn't actually a destination, it's a process and a journey".

The weekend's discussions culminated with a 'Talk with The Times', during which Liz Alderman, Steven Erlanger and Patrick Healy from The New York Times, debated on the role of democracy in our current societies, focusing on issues of inclusivity and diversity and on how to best engage and mobilise the younger generations.

The memorable weekend was attended by an international audience – including delegates from this year's Athens Democracy Forum, and guests staying at **The Romanos**, a **Luxury Collection Resort**, Costa Navarino. In addition to the series of talks and book readings, guests were also invited to join other experiences including a philosophy walk with academics discussing modern-day ethics through the lens of ancient Greek philosophers.
